General Description

Bering 78 is an enhanced version of our flagship B70. Her design is based on three years of customer experience with the B70 model, which helped finding areas for improvement and led to the key changes.

We have increased the LOA and the beam by a meter. A wider and longer B78 provides more comfort for guests and crew without compromising the advantages of a sturdy and capable expedition vessel under 24 meters long.





Interiors

After constructing several B70 hulls, we have developed an improved version within the 70-foot range - B78. Every detail, from the internal design to layout, has been meticulously curated using the most exquisite materials.

Experience the spacious deck with wide side decks thoughtfully designed for effortless line handling and convenient fender placement during docking. A spacious sunbed is located just forward of the pilothouse. Aft, the partially covered cockpit offers ample open space with built-in seating and a teak table for 12 people. With its extended hull, this yacht is an optimal choice for a family or a group of friends eager to share their expedition experiences.










