## Bering Yachts' Latest Cruiser Hits The Water For Testing (VIDEO)

Hull number one of the recently debuted Bering 70 is officially afloat and undergoing preliminary sea trials according to a company press release.

Designed as a coastal cruiser with long-range abilities, the B70 features a relatively shallow draft (4' 6") coupled with a reported range of 2,500 miles at a cruising speed of 8 knots.

In typical Bering fashion, the B70 features a steel hull married to a composite superstructure. A single-level pilothouse and slightly reverse-raked bow give off a strong *eau de* patrol boat tightly wrapped in a fashionable gun-metal grey.



Though Bering plans to offer semi-custom variations, hull number one features a three en-suite staterooms plus an additional quarters for crew.
