Bering 80 launched

Bering Yachts is proud to announce the successful launch of the Bering 80, Veda.

The full displacement steel yacht is currently the flagship of the Bering fleet and the fourth vessel in the Expedition Class series. The boat is the heaviest in her class, displacing over 235 tons and has a fuel capacity of over 10,000 gallons.



With a masculine exterior in blue/gray, the vessel is complemented by a classic rich makore wood interior enhanced with marbles, granites and handcrafted

furniture.



Spacious and practical, Veda features a 7.8m beam and the ability to comfortably accommodate eight guests across her four staterooms, all with en-suite bathrooms.



The yacht is powered by twin Cummins QSM-11, 350 hp engines, has a range of 6,000 nautical miles at a speed of 9 knots and can reach a maximum speed of

12 knots.

Veda is a true expedition vessel, maintaining the quality finishes and the typical luxury of a superyacht.
